Re: Diabetic Supplies and Continuous Glucose Monitor Coverage Update

The Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS) has included certain diabetic supplies, including continuous glucose monitors (CGMs), on the statewide Preferred Drug List (PDL). These supplies may be obtained through a participating pharmacy or durable medical equipment (DME) provider.

Beginning November 2, 2026, providers dispensing continuous glucose monitors must adhere to the statewide PDL, available at www.PAPDL.com. Prior authorization is required for any non-preferred devices or supplies, or for items identified on the PDL as requiring prior authorization.

As a reminder, providers must include the appropriate National Drug Code (NDC) on claims for supplies added to the statewide PDL.

Members and Participants may continue to receive their diabetic supplies through participating DME providers or network pharmacies. Effective, November 2, 2026, prior authorization requests for CGM diabetic supplies added to the PDL must be submitted to the AmeriHealth Caritas PA/AmeriHealth Caritas PA CHC Pharmacy Services Department.
